Our gift shop sells jewellery, historic toys, and books on local history. If you have a heritage lover in the family we have the perfect gift for them!



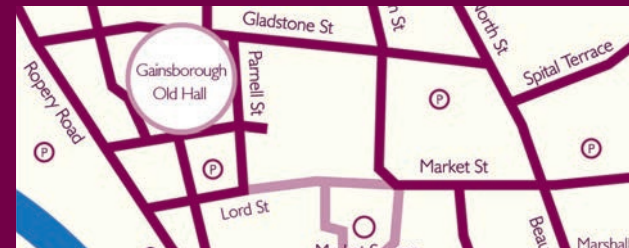
